**<sup>4</sup>Median SAT Scores:** SAT scores for public schools are the median (50th percentile); for non-public schools, the range is from the 25th to 75th percentile. These numbers are based on the old scale, in which a 1600 represented a perfect score.

\*SAT scores for these schools were either not available or are not disclosed.
