⁴ 4th Grade Exams: This is the percentage of students who placed in levels 3 and 4 on the 2004 New York State 4th

Grade Math and Reading exams. Students at levels 3 and 4 meet or exceed standards. Those at level 1 have serious deficiencies and those at level 2 do not have full mastery of the standards. District 1 and 2 schools are now part of Region 9; District 3 is in Region 10.
