3Student-Teacher Ratio: For public schools, this information comes from www.greatschools.net and is for the 2002-2003 school year. For independent and religious schools, this comes from www.nces.ed.gov and is for the 2003-2004 school year.

48th Grade Exams: This is the percentage of students who placed in levels 3 and 4 on the 2004 New York State 8th Grade Math and Reading exams. Students at levels 3 and 4 meet or exceed standards. Those at level 1 have

serious deficiencies and those at level 2 do not have full mastery of the standards. District 1, 2 and 4 schools are now part of Region 9; District 3 is in Region 10.

*These schools either do not administer the exams or do not report the results.
