### 3 Average Class Size/Student-Teacher Ratio: For public schools, this number represents average class size. The figures come from www.inside-schools.org and are from the year of the school visit, noted in each school's profile. For independent and religious schools, this number represents student-teacher ratio. The figures come from the website www.nces.ed.gov for the 2003-2004 school year, or from the schools themselves as of 2006.

4 4th Grade Exams: This is the percentage of students who placed in levels 3 and 4 on the 2004-2005 New York State 4th Grade Math and Reading exams. Students at levels 3 and 4 meet or exceed standards. Those at level 1 have serious deficiencies and those at level 2 do not have full mastery of the standards.
